COMMISSION STAFF'S RECOMMENDATION ON ADMINISTRATIVE COMPLETENESS AND PROPOSED PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

COMES NOW the Commission Staff of the Public Utility Commission of Texas (Staff), representing the public interest, and in response to Order No. 1, files this Recommendation on Administrative Completeness and Proposed Procedural Schedule. Staff recommends that the application be deemed administratively complete. In support thereof, Staff shows the following:

I. BACKGROUND

On June 7, 2019, MSEC Waste Water Inc. (MSEC Waste) and MSEC Enterprises Inc. (MSEC Enterprises)(collectively, Applicants) filed an application for Sale, Transfer, or Merger of Facilities and Certificate Rights in Montgomery County, Texas. Specifically, MSEC Waste seeks approval to purchase facilities and transfer MSEC Enterprises' wastewater Certificate of Convenience and Necessity (CCN) No. 20984. The requested area includes approximately 373 total acres and 3 current customers.

On June 14, 2019, Order No. 1 was issued establishing a deadline of July 8, 2019 for Staff to file a recommendation on the administrative completeness of the application and notice and propose a procedural schedule for further processing of the application. Therefore, this pleading is timely filed.

II. ADMINISTRATIVE COMPLETENESS

As supported by the attached memorandum of Debbie Reyes in the Commission's Water Utility Regulation Division, Staff has reviewed the application and recommends that the application be found administratively complete.

III. NOTICE

The Commission's notice requirement for sale, transfer, merger applications are provided by 16 Texas Administrative Code (TAC) § 24.239. Specifically, Staff recommends that Applicants be ordered to provide notice as detailed in the attached memorandum of Debbie Reyes.

IV. PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

Staff recommends the application be found administratively complete. Staff therefore proposes the following procedural schedule:

Event	Date
Deadline for Applicants to file proof of notice with the Commission	August 22, 2019
Deadline for Staff to file a recommendation on sufficiency of notice	Within 10 days of Applicants filing proof of completed notice with the Commission
Deadline to intervene	30 days after notice is issued

V. CONCLUSION

For the reasons discussed above, Staff respectfully recommends that the application be found administratively complete, that Applicants be directed to provide notice as detailed above and in the attached memorandum, and that the procedural schedule proposed above be adopted for further processing of this docket.

On June 7, 2019, MSEC Waste Water Inc.'s. (Purchaser or MSEC Waste), and MSEC Enterprises Inc.'s (Seller or MSEC Enterprises) (collectively Applicants) filed an application for Sale, Transfer, or Merger (STM) of facilities and certificate rights in Montgomery County, Texas. Specifically, MSEC Waste seeks approval to purchase facilities and transfer MSEC Enterprises' wastewater Certificate of Convenience and Necessity (CCN) No. 20984. The requested area includes approximately 373 total acres and 3 current customers. This application is being reviewed under 16 Texas Administrative Code (TAC) §§ 24.227 and 24.239 and Texas Water Code (TWC) §§ 13.241, 13.246, and 13.301.

Staff has reviewed the application information and recommends that the application be deemed sufficient for filing and be found administratively complete. Staff further recommends the Applicant be ordered to do the following:

- 1) Provide notice of the application to the following:
 - a) cities, districts, and neighboring retail public utilities providing the same utility service whose corporate boundaries or certificated service area are located within two miles from the outer boundary of the requested area;
 - b) the county judge of each county that is wholly or partially included in the requested area:
 - c) each groundwater conservation district that is wholly or partially included in the requested area; and
 - d) any affected customers, and other affected parties in the requested area.
- 2) Provide correct notice of the application to the following:
 - Aqua Texas Inc. (CCN No. 21065)
 - SC Utilities (CCN No. 20586)
 - Stanley Lake MUD (CCN No. 20483)
 - City of Conroe
 - City of Montgomery
 - Martin Creek MUD
 - San Jacinto River Authority
 - Lone Star Groundwater Conservation District

- Montgomery County Judge
- 3) Provide an individual notice to neighboring utilities, other affected parties, and customers. Information related to districts including addresses can be obtained by the Applicant from the TCEQ's web site located at http://www14.tceq.texas.gov/iwud/
- 4) File in the docket a copy of notice along with an affidavit specifying every person and entity to whom notice was provided, the date that the notice was provided, and the publisher's affidavit for proof of newspaper publication. It is recommended that the Applicant use the attached notice and affidavit to meet these requirements.
