**ORDER NO. 2  
FINDING APPLICATION INCOMPLETE AND DEFICIENT,  
AND ESTABLISHING AN OPPORTUNITY TO CURE**

This Order addresses the application of Kempner Water Supply Corporation and the City of Copperas Cove for sale, transfer, or merger of facilities and certificate rights and Commission Staff's recommendation on the administrative completeness of the application.

The administrative law judge finds the application incomplete and deficient. Under 16 Texas Administrative Code § 24.8(d), the Commission does not consider an application filed until it makes a determination that the application is administratively complete. Thus, at this time the application is not considered filed with the Commission.

On or before August 16, 2019, the applicants must supplement the application to cure the deficiencies as described in the July 15, 2019 memorandum by Maxine Gilford. Until the Commission receives and reviews the supplemental information, the application cannot proceed. The applicants must not issue notice until the application is deemed administratively complete.

On or before September 19, 2019, Commission Staff must file a supplemental recommendation regarding the administrative completeness of the application, along with a proposed procedural schedule, if appropriate.
