ORDER NO. 5 FINDING NOTICE SUFFICIENT AND ESTABLISHING PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

This Order addresses the July 1, 2019 application of Perry Water Supply Corporation and Tri-County Special Utility District for approval of a sale, transfer, or merger of facilities and certificate rights in Falls, McClennan, Robertson, and Limestone counties and the sufficiency of notice.

On October 11, 2019, the applicants filed an affidavit of notice, indicating that notice of application was mailed to current customers, neighboring utilities, and affected parties on October 4, 2019. On October 29, 2019, the applicants filed a copy of the actual notice provided to all affected parties.

The administrative law judge finds notice sufficient and adopts the following procedural schedule:
