**ORDER NO. 13
ADMITTING EVIDENCE, REQUIRING STATUS REPORT, AND RESTYLING
DOCKET**

This Order addresses the parties' joint motion to admit evidence, filed on September 18, 2020, and the corrected agreed motion to admit evidence, filed on September 23, 2020. The administrative law judge grants the motions and admits the following documents as evidence in the record of this proceeding:

1. The applicants' report on completion of transfer filed on June 10, 2020;
2. Commission Staff's recommendation on sufficiency of the closing documents filed on June 25, 2020;
3. The applicants' consent forms filed on September 16, 2020; and
4. The final map and certificate filed on September 23, 2020.

Additionally, this Order addresses the need for Tri-County Special Utility District to file a status report on its current compliance status regarding arsenic. Specifically, Tri-County SUD's December 13, 2019 response to Commission Staff's request for information included correspondence from the United States Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) with a May 31, 2020 deadline to achieve and maintain compliance with the maximum contaminant levels for arsenic. On or before December 4, 2020, Tri-County SUD must file a status report addressing its current compliance status with Texas Commission on Environmental Quality and EPA requirements concerning arsenic.


Finally, this Order addresses the need to restyle this proceeding to accurately reflect that the location of the facilities and service area being sold and transferred. Specifically, Perry Water Supply Corporation's facilities and water certificate of convenience and necessity service

area are located only in Falls county. Accordingly, this docket is restyled as reflected in this Order.
