**ORDER NO. 2
ADDRESSING SUFFICIENCY OF APPLICATION AND NOTICE;
ESTABLISHING PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE**

This Order addresses the application of Oncor Electric Delivery Company LLC to amend its certificate of convenience and necessity for a 345 kilovolt (kV) transmission line in Reeves and Ward Counties.

On July 26, 2019, Oncor filed the affidavit of W. Chris Reily, Regulatory Manager, External Affairs, attesting that notice was provided by mail to neighboring utilities, counties, Office of Public Utility Counsel, Texas Parks and Wildlife, and the Department of Defense Siting Clearinghouse on July 19, 2019.

On August 15, 2019, Oncor filed affidavits attesting to the publication of newspaper notice: the affidavit of Smokey Briggs, owner, attesting to the publication in *The Monahans News* on July 25, 2019, and the affidavit of Christina Bitolas, advertising manager, attesting to the publication in the *Pecos Enterprise* on July 25, 2019.


The administrative law judge deems the application materially complete and sufficient for further review and approves the provision of notice.
