
**OFFICE OF PUBLIC UTILITY COUNSEL'S

Pursuant to Texas Utilities Code §§ 13.001 and 13.003(a)(3)(A)-(B), and 16 Texas Administrative Code § 22.103(b), the Office of Public Utility Counsel (“OPUC”) moves to intervene in this proceeding as a matter of right on behalf of the residential and small commercial consumers in Southwestern Electric Power Company’s (“SWEPCO”) service territory.
