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**ORDER NO. 5  
GRANTING MOTION TO INTERVENE**


This Order addresses the motion to intervene of East Texas Electric Cooperative, Inc. (ETEC) and Northeast Texas Electric Cooperative, Inc. (NTEC) filed on July 26, 2019. ETEC and NTEC stated that they are wholesale power customers of Southwestern Electric Power Company (SWEPCO) and transmission customers in the Southwest Power Pool; therefore, their interests may be adversely affected by the outcome of this proceeding. ETEC and NTEC appear to have a justiciable interest in this proceeding. No objection to the motion to intervene was filed.

The administrative law judge grants the motions to intervene.
