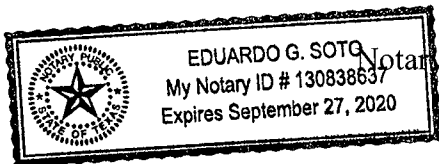

Unincorporated area of Westcliffe northwest of the incorporated area of Belton that runs North West along the Lake Belton banks for 3. 11 miles with the south side running along Farm to market rd 439 until it intersects Sparta Rd than going north west for 2 miles then going north until banks of Lake Belton.

Unincorporated area of Woodland which covers 1.55 square miles running along the banks of Lake Belton just northwest of the incorporated area of Woodland/Temple with the north east corner begins at the intersection of FM 2271 and FM 2305 going north west on FM 2305 1.8 miles until the banks of Lake Belton and going southwest on FM 2271 1.1 miles.

THENCE North 00°33'48" West, along the East line of said HRB Farms, Ltd. tract, a distance of 670.00 feet to a ½ inch iron rod found for corner;

THENCE North 89°36'20" East a distance of 816.73 feet to a ½ inch iron rod found for corner in a curve to the left whose chord bears South 02°03'45" West, 25.37 feet;

THENCE Southerly along said curve to the left having a central angle of 1°39'27", a radius of 877/00 feet and an arc length 25.27 feet to a point;

THENCE South 28°46'01" East a distance of 24.52 feet to a ½ inch iron rod found for corner in the West line of said Tittle Drive and in a curve to the left whose chords bears South 00°17'02" East, 3.33 feet;

THENCE Southerly along the West line of said Tittle Drive and the curve to the left having a central angle of 0°13'15", a radius of 865.00 feet and an arc length of 3.33 feet to a point;

THENCE South 00°23'40" East, along the West line of said Tittle Drive a distance of 619/74 feet to the POINT OF BEGINNING and containing 12.700 acres of land, more or less.

Travis County, Texas

The Riverhorse Ranch Apartments as defined by the area bounded by Grand Avenue Parkway, Central Commerce Drive, and White River Boulevard.

McLennan County, Texas

Northward along and to the west of Speegleville Road from Maple Shade Street to New Windsor Parkway (FM 3047), including properties along Pioneer Circle, Wagner Drive, Chisholm Drive and River Oaks Drive.

A suburb of the Waco Metropolitan Statistical Area known as

Speegleville. The community is located along Texas State Highway 6 around 8 miles to the west of the City of Waco on the western edge of Lake Waco.

A suburb of the Waco Metropolitan Statistical Area known as China Springs located in the Northwestern part of McLennan County along Farm Road 1637 twelve miles northwest of The City of Waco

Nueces County, Texas

The most Northern point starts at the Southern side of Kennedy Memorial Causeway, also known as S. Padre Island Dr., where it spans the inland waterway North of the intersection of Aloha St and Suntan Ave. (27°37'53.77"N, 97°13'57.21"W). Follow the midline of the inland waterway Southwest to the canal just before Carlos 5th Ct on the South, turn East into the canal and follow on its midline until it forks. Turn South into canal where Top Sail Street is located to the East and Cobo de Bara Circle to the West. Follow the midline of the canal keeping a Southwest direction, then cross on to land keeping Tesoro Dr. to the West until Whitecap Blvd. Go West on the Northern side of Whitecap Blvd. until reach the canal just West of Isabella Ct but East of Bonasse Ct. Follow the midline of that canal until reach inland waterway at end of Isabella Ct. Turn East into the midline of the inland waterway passing over Gypsy St., with Bounty Ave on Northern side. At Northern corner of Cutlass Ave and Western side Cuttysark St, head South along Western side of Cuttysark St. a total of approximately 975 feet. Turn East for approximately 1200 feet to reach the Western side of S. Padre Island Drive. Go North on S. Padre Island Dr until intersect with Northern side of Commodores St. Head West on the Northern side of Commodores St until reach canal. Go North in the midline of the canal until Southern side of Jackfish Ave. Head East on Southern side of Jackfish Ave to Western side of S. Padre Island Dr. Head North/West on Western side S. Padre Island Dr to the Northern start point.

6. The Applicant shall agree to provide the Commission with written notification when terminating its SICFA. The Applicant shall also agree to provide the Commission with a copy of any order or ruling issued by a court of competent jurisdiction or the Federal Communications Commission (FCC) that either modifies or revokes its SICFA or makes it

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ineligible to hold a SICFA pursuant to the standards laid out in PURA § 66.003(b). (Commission Staff shall establish a project number to submit all written notices and copies of orders or rulings concerning SICFAs.) The Applicant shall make an affirmative statement that it agrees to provide written notification of termination and copies of orders or rulings issued by a court of competent jurisdiction or the FCC concerning its SICFA.
