COMMISSION STAFF'S RECOMMENDATION ON SUFFICIENCY

COMES NOW the Staff of the Public Utility Commission of Texas (Staff), representing the public interest and files this recommendation. Staff recommends that the application be found sufficient for further review. In support thereof, Staff would show the following:

I. BACKGROUND

On July 24, 2019, Oncor Electric Delivery Company LLC (Oncor) filed an application for interim update of wholesale transmission rates. Oncor requested an interim revision to its previously-approved transmission cost of service (TCOS) and wholesale transmission rates pursuant to, and consistent with, the requirements of 16 Tex. Admin. Code (TAC) § 25.192(h).

On July 29, 2019, the Administrative Law Judge issued Order No. 1, setting a deadline of August 15, 2019 to file a motion to find the application materially deficient. This pleading, therefore, is timely filed.

II. SUFFICIENCY

Staff has reviewed Oncor's application and recommends that it be found sufficient. Staff expresses no opinion at this time regarding the merits of Oncor's application.

III. NOTICE

On August 6, 2019, Oncor filed an affidavit attesting to the provision of notice. Therein, Oncor stated that on July 25, 2019, notice was mailed, via first-class mail, to all parties in the last

complete review of Oncor's transmission cost of service,¹ and to all of the distribution service providers included on the matrix in the latest docket in which the Commission set the annual wholesale transmission service charges for the Electric Reliability Council of Texas.² Pursuant to 16 TAC § 22.55, Staff has determined that such notice is reasonable. Accordingly, Staff recommends that Oncor's notice be found sufficient.

IV. CONCLUSION

For the reasons stated above, Staff respectfully recommends that Oncor's application and notice be deemed sufficient.



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
