The agreement contains specific terms and conditions that are confidential, including pricing, engineering, and operational information. Public disclosure of this information could put SPS/Xcel Energy and Vestas at a competitive disadvantage when negotiating future wind energy agreements. Public disclosure of the agreement could also subject SPS/Xcel Energy to contractual liability under the terms of the agreement. Finally, the agreement also contains engineering and technical specifications that are protected under the trade secret privilege in Rule 507 of the Texas Rules of Civil Evidence, which is made applicable to the discovery process by Rule 192.3 of the Texas Rules of Civil Procedure.
