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



NOTICE OF APPLICATION TO AMEND A WATER CERTIFICATE OF CONVENIENCE AND NECESSITY IN NUECES COUNTY, TEXAS

River Acres Water Supply Corporation has filed an application with the Public Utility Commission of Texas to amend its Certificate of Convenience and Necessity (CCN) No. 11084 for the provision of retail water utility service in Nueces County.

Requested Water Service Areas:

Area 1: The requested area is located approximately 6 miles north of downtown Robstown, TX, and is generally bounded on the north by Miller Road; on the east by CR 75; on the south by Northwest Boulevard; and on the west by CR 77. The total requested area includes approximately 483 acres and 0 current customers.

Area 2: The requested area is located approximately 4 miles north of downtown Robstown, TX, and is generally bounded on the north by Northwest Boulevard; on the east by FM 1889; on the south by Amanda Lane and on the west by Carousal Lane. The total requested area includes approximately 333 acres and 1 current customers.

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If a valid public hearing is requested, the Commission will forward the application to the State Office of Administrative Hearings (SOAH) for a hearing. If no settlement is reached and an evidentiary hearing is held, SOAH will submit a recommendation to the Commission for a final decision. An evidentiary hearing is a legal proceeding similar to a civil trial in state district court.

A landowner with a tract of land of at least 25 acres or more, that is partially or wholly located within the requested area, may file a written request with the Commission to be excluded from the requested area ("opt out") within 30 days from the date that notice was provided by the utility. All opt out requests must include a large-scale map

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
