FINDING NOTICE DEFICIENT AND ESTABLISHING A PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

This Order addresses the proof of notice filed by River Acres Water Supply Corporation on July 28 and 31, 2020. On August 6, 2020, Commission Staff filed a recommendation regarding the sufficiency of notice and proposed a procedural schedule.

The administrative law judge (ALJ) finds the notice to be deficient. Specifically, River Acres has not demonstrated that it provided notice of the application to the Nueces County Judge. Further, while River Acres' July 31, 2020 filing contained a publisher's affidavit, the affidavit was left blank. River Acres is required to provide notice of the application to the Nueces County Judge and demonstrate proof of published notice by filing a completed publisher's affidavit.

The ALJ adopts the following procedural schedule:

Event	Date
Deadline for River Acres to file signed affidavit that notice was given to the Nueces County Judge, along with a completed publisher's affidavit and a copy of the notice mailed to the affected parties and published	August 28, 2020
Deadline for Commission Staff to file a supplemental recommendation on the sufficiency of notice and propose a supplemental procedural schedule	September 9, 2020
Deadline to intervene	30 days after notice is issued
