ESTABLISHING PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE**


This Order addresses the application filed by River Acres Water Supply Corporation for an amendment to its water certificate of convenience and necessity in Nueces County and the sufficiency of notice. River Acres filed proof of mailed and published notice on August 7, 2020, reflecting that notice was mailed to affected parties on July 1 and 2, 2020 and was published in the *Corpus Christi Caller Times*, a newspaper of general circulation in Nueces County, on July 11 and 18, 2020. River Acres filed supplemental proof of notice on September 8, 2020 to correct omissions in its prior proof of notice documentation. On September 30, 2020, Commission Staff recommended that notice be found sufficient.

The administrative law judge (ALJ) finds notice sufficient. The ALJ adopts the following procedural schedule:

If no hearing is requested, deadline for the parties to file joint proposed findings of fact, conclusions of law, and ordering paragraphs	December 4, 2020
