



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# ORDER NO. 1 REQUIRING PETITIONER INFORMATION, COMMENTS ON ADMINISTRATIVE COMPLETENESS AND NOTICE; AND ESTABLISHING PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

#### I. Petition

This Order addresses the petition of Alamo Mission LLC for streamlined expedited release from the Rockett Special Utility District's water certificate of convenience and necessity (CCN) in Ellis County. Alamo Mission seeks the expedited release of approximately 166.594 acres of land within the boundaries of Rockett SUD's CCN number 10099.

#### II. Petitioner Information

On or before August 30, 2019, Alamo Mission must file the following information and supporting documentation:

- 1. The legal name and all assumed names, if any, under which the applicant conducts business. If the applicant uses an assumed name, provide a currently valid certificate of assumed name.
- 2. The form of business in Texas (e.g., corporation, partnership, sole proprietorship), Charter or Authorization number, date business was formed, and date change was made (if applicable).
- 3. Legal name of parent company, if any, and a description of its primary business interests and the name of any companies affiliated with the applicant with which it does any business. Provide the state and date in which the parent company is registered. (The Commission requires registration with the Secretary of State for all forms of business, except sole proprietorships.).



## III. Requiring Comments on the Administrative Completeness

By September 16, 2019, Commission Staff must file comments regarding the administrative completeness of the petition and notice.

Rockett SUD or any other interested person must file a motion to intervene by September 16, 2019, in order to participate as a party in this proceeding.

## IV. Establishing Procedural Schedule

The following procedural schedule applies to this proceeding:

Commission Staff's comments on the administrative	September 16,
completeness of the petition and notice	2019
Deadline for Rockett SUD and other affected persons to	September 16,
file a motion to intervene or comment on the petition	2019

Additional deadlines will be established after the petition is deemed administratively complete.

# V. Filing Requirements

Unless otherwise specified, an original and ten copies of documents relating to this proceeding must be filed with the Commission's filing clerk in accordance with 16 TAC § 22.71. A copy of each document filed with the Commission must also be served on all parties as required by 16 TAC § 22.74. All filings can be accessed on the PUC Interchange webpage at, <a href="http://interchange.puc.texas.gov">http://interchange.puc.texas.gov</a>.

All parties will provide their current addresses, telephone and fax numbers, if available, to all other parties and the Commission by filing and serving all parties with such information. Each party must provide the Commission and all parties with updated address, telephone, and fax information, if such information changes. The telephone and fax numbers will be placed on the service list for this proceeding. Parties are responsible for updating their own service lists to reflect changed information and the addition of any other parties.

### VI. Ex Parte Communications

Ex parte communications with the administrative law judge (ALJ) are prohibited under 16 TAC § 22.3(b)(2). Parties should communicate with the ALJ only through written documents filed with the Commission's filing clerk and served on all parties.
