ORDER NO. 9 CONTINUING ABATEMENT

This Order addresses Commission Staff's report concerning the status of litigation related to this docket. Commission Staff stated that the federal appellate case¹ regarding the issue of federal preemption is ongoing and that there has been no procedural change in that case since May 19, 2020, when parties submitted additional information at the request of the oral argument panel. The administrative law judge finds that the present matter should continue to be abated.

Accordingly, the processing of this proceeding continues to be abated. On or before October 15, 2020, Commission Staff must file a status report concerning the status of the litigation.
