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ORDER NO. 3 ESTABLISHING REVISED PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

This Order addresses Commission Staff's November 15, 2019, request to extend the time to file its final recommendation or request a hearing in this case. Commission Staff states that additional time is needed to evaluate whether the amount Mr. Newman paid to obtain service from MJC Water Supply Corporation was consistent with its tariff, is reasonably related to the cost of installing on-site and off-site facilities to provide service, and for Commission Staff to formulate its final recommendation.

The administrative law judge grants Commission Staff's request for extension and revises the remainder of the procedural schedule as follows:
