**ORDER NO. 8**  
**FINDING NOTICE DEFICIENT AND ESTABLISHING A PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE**

This Order addresses the proof of notice provided by Swift Water Supply Corporation on May 27, 2020. On June 22, 2020, Commission Staff filed a recommendation regarding the sufficiency of notice and proposed a procedural schedule.

The administrative law judge (ALJ) finds the notice to be deficient. Specifically, Swift WSC did not provide proof that notice was mailed to the 62 current customers in the requested area. Swift WSC is required to file an affidavit regarding customer notice along with a list of the customers noticed and copies of the notice and maps provided to the current customers.

The ALJ adopts the following procedural schedule:

Event	Date
Deadline for Swift WSC to file supplemental proof of notice	July 13, 2020
Deadline for Commission Staff to file a supplemental recommendation on the sufficiency of notice	July 23, 2020
Deadline for Commission Staff to file a recommendation on the sufficiency of Swift WSC's mapping revisions to reflect opt-outs	July 23, 2020
