Southwestern Bell Telephone Company¹ d/b/a AT&T Texas ("AT&T TEXAS") and Airus, Inc. ("CLEC") (collectively the "Applicants") hereby submit this Joint Application ("Application") for Approval of an Interconnection Amendment ("Amendment") thereto, under the Telecommunications Act of 1996 ("the Act") and the Public Utility Regulatory Act ("PURA"), and would respectfully show the Public Utility Commission of Texas (the "Commission") the following:

### I. Amendment

The Applicants present this Application for approval pursuant to the terms of Section 252 of the Act, PURA, and applicable PUC Procedural Rules. Said Amendment is being incorporated into the Agreement already approved by the Commission on June 20, 2017 in Docket No. 47254. Said Amendment adds rates and terms for Alternate 911 services.

The Applicants' Affidavits explaining how the Amendment is consistent with the public interest, convenience, and necessity, including all relevant requirements of law, are filed with this Application as Attachments II and III.

### II. Request for Approval

The Applicants jointly seek the Commission's final approval of this Application, pursuant to applicable PUC Procedural Rules. The Application complies with said Rules and Section 252(e) of the Act because the proposed Amendment is procompetitive and does not discriminate against any telecommunications carrier that is not a party thereto, and is consistent with the public interest, convenience, and necessity and consistent with other requirements of state law. There are no outstanding issues between the parties requiring mediation or arbitration.

The Applicants respectfully request that the Commission grant final approval of this Application, without change, suspension or other delay in its implementation. The Applicants do not believe a docket or intervention by other parties is necessary or appropriate.

### III. Standard for Review

The statutory standards of review are set forth in Section 252(e) of the Act and applicable Procedural Rules. The respective affidavits of the AT&T TEXAS REPRESENTATIVE, filed herein as Attachment II and the CLEC REPRESENTATIVE filed herein as Attachment III, establish that the Amendment submitted herein satisfies these standards.

### IV. SPCOA Information

Airus, Inc. warrants that, to the extent required, it has sought and obtained approval of a SPCOA, and is duly authorized to serve the geographic area of the entire state of Texas.

### AMENDMENT TO INTERCONNECTION AGREEMENT BETWEEN SOUTHWESTERN BELL TELEPHONE COMPANY d/b/a AT&T TEXAS AND Airus, Inc.

This Amendment amends the Interconnection Agreement by and between Southwestern Bell Telephone Company d/b/a AT&T Texas ("AT&T") and Airus, Inc. ("CLEC"). AT&T and CLEC are hereinafter referred to collectively as the "Parties" and individually as a "Party". This Amendment applies in AT&T's service territory in the State of Texas.

### WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, AT&T and CLEC are Parties to an Interconnection Agreement under Sections 251 and 252 of the Communications Act of 1934, as amended (the "Act"), dated May 3, 2017 (the "Agreement");

WHEREAS, the Parties wish to amend the Agreement to reflect certain changes relating to 911 found in the Public Utility Commission of Texas Substantive Rules, 26.433(i) and 26.272(e)(1)(B)(vi), and

**NOW**, **THEREFORE**, in consideration of the promises and mutual agreements set forth herein, the Parties agree to amend the Agreement as follows:

- 1. Recitals. The above recitals are hereby incorporated in their entirety into this Amendment.
- 2. This Amendment adds terms and conditions for 911 Service referenced in the Alternative 911 Service Attachment when CLEC is providing 911 Service to its end-user customers using an alternative 911 Service arrangement approved by the appropriate 911 administrative agency.
- 3. EXCEPT AS MODIFIED HEREIN, ALL OTHER TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF THE UNDERLYING AGREEMENT SHALL REMAIN UNCHANGED AND IN FULL FORCE AND EFFECT.
- 4. In entering into this Amendment, neither Party waives, and each Party expressly reserves, any rights, remedies or arguments it may have at law or under the intervening law or regulatory change provisions in the underlying Agreement (including intervening law rights asserted by either Party via written notice predating this Amendment) with respect to any orders, decisions, legislation or proceedings and any remands thereof, which the Parties have not yet fully incorporated into this Agreement or which may be the subject of further review.
- 5. This Amendment shall not modify or extend the Effective Date or Term of the underlying Agreement, but rather, shall be coterminous with such Agreement.
- 6. The Parties acknowledge and agree that this Amendment shall be filed with and is subject to approval by the Public Utility Commission of Texas (Commission) and shall become effective upon approval by such Commission (the "Amendment Effective Date").

### 1.0 **INTRODUCTION**

- 1.1 This Attachment sets forth the terms and conditions for 911 Service when CLEC is providing 911 service to its End Users using an alternative 911 service arrangement approved by the appropriate 911 administrative agency.
- 1.2 In the event AT&T TEXAS is the 911 network service provider and CLEC is not connecting directly to AT&T TEXAS to provide its End Users access to 911 service, AT&T TEXAS shall not provision or activate CLEC's voice trunks until CLEC provides AT&T TEXAS: (1) a written representation that CLEC is providing 911 service to its End Users using an alternative 911 service arrangement, and (2) written approval of CLEC's 911 service arrangement by the appropriate 911 administrative agency.
- 1.3 Notwithstanding anything to the contrary, so long as the requirements set forth above are met, 911 testing is not required to pass non-911 traffic to and from End Users for which CLEC does not offer 911 Service through AT&T TEXAS.
