COMMISSION STAFF'S FINAL RECOMMENDATION

COMES NOW the Staff (Staff) of the Public Utility Commission of Texas (Commission), representing the public interest, and files this Final Recommendation. In support thereof, Staff shows the following:

I. BACKGROUND

On August 30, 2019, Maple Heights Development LLC (Maple Heights) filed a petition for expedited release of approximately 211 acres of land within the boundaries of Porter Municipal Utility District (Porter MUD) sewer certificate of convenience and necessity number (CCN) No. 20573 in Montgomery County, under Texas Water Code § 13.254(a-5) and 16 Texas Administrative Code (TAC) § 24.245(*l*). Maple Heights asserts that the land is at least 25 contiguous acres, is not receiving water service, and is located in Montgomery County, which is a qualifying county. Maple Heights filed supplemental information on October 24, 2019.

Porter MUD filed a request to intervene on October 11, 2019. On October 23, 2019, Order No. 3 was issued, granting Porter MUD's request to intervene.

On December 3, 2019, Order No. 4 was issued, establishing a deadline of December 17, 2019, for Staff to file a recommendation on the final disposition of the application. Therefore, this pleading is timely filed.

II. RECOMMENDATION

As supported by the attached memorandum of Roshan Pokhrel, Engineering Specialist of the Commission's Infrastructure Division, Division (Attachment A). Staff has reviewed the petition for expedited release and recommends that it be approved. The maps and digital data filed by Maple Heights provide adequate information to demonstrate that Maple Heights satisfies the requirements of TWC § 13.254(a-5) and 16 TAC § 24.245(1). Specifically, the petition

demonstrates that the property for which the Applicant seeks expedited release is located in a qualifying county (Montgomery County), is not receiving sewer service, and that the aggregated, contiguous tracts of land make up a single property that is at least 25 acres. In addition, the deeds submitted by Maple Heights provide confirmation of Maple Heights' ownership in the property. Consequently, Maple Heights has shown through its petition that it meets the requirements for expedited release.

Furthermore, Staff did not identify any property that would be rendered useless or valueless by the decertification. If the Commission determines that there is no useless or valueless property, pursuant to 16 TAC § 24.245(n)(7), Staff further recommends that a compensation proceeding is not necessary.

Therefore, Staff recommends that Maple Heights' petition be approved. The final sewer CCN map (Attachment B) and sewer CCN (Attachment C) are attached to this filing.

III. CONCLUSION

For the reasons detailed above, Staff respectfully recommends that Maple Heights's petition be approved.

On August 30, 2019, Maple Heights Development LLC (Petitioner) filed an application for expedited release from Porter Municipal Utility District's (Porter MUD) sewer Certificate of Convenience and Necessity (CCN) No. 20573 in Montgomery County, under Texas Water Code § 13.254(a-5) and 16 Texas Administrative Code (TAC) § 24.245(*l*). The Petitioner asserts that the land is at least 25 contiguous acres, is not receiving sewer service, and is located in Montgomery County, which is a qualifying county.

The Petitioner submitted adequate maps delineating the requested area for expedited release with enough detail to confirm the accurate positioning of its digital data pursuant to 16 TAC § 24.245(m). The map and digital data are sufficient for determining the locations of the requested release areas within Porter MUD's certificated area. Mapping Staff was able to confirm the acreage of the subject property and determined that the requested areas are located within Porter MUD's sewer CCN. Furthermore, the Petitioner provided warranty deeds confirming the Petitioner's ownership of the tracts of land within Porter MUD's certificated area. In addition, the Petitioner submitted a sworn affidavit attesting that the property was not receiving sewer service from the CCN holder. The area being requested for expedited release is approximately 204 acres.


Porter MUD requested to intervene on October 11, 2019 and the intervention was granted by the Administrative Law Judge on October 23, 2019. Staff recommends that there is no useless or valueless property. If the commission determines that there is no useless and valueless property, under 16 TAC § 24.245(n)(7), Staff further recommends that a compensation proceeding is not necessary.

In accordance with TWC § 13.254(a-5) and 16 TAC § 24.245(l), the Petitioners have met the Commission's requirements to allow for the release of the requested area from Porter MUD's CCN No. 20573. Therefore, Staff recommends approval of the petition. Enclosed is a final map and certificate for Commission approval.

Additionally, Staff recommends that a final map and certificate be provided to the CCN holder. In accordance with TWC §§ 13.257 (r)-(s), Staff further recommends that Porter MUD file the following information in the Montgomery County Clerk's office: (1) a certified copy of the CCN map; (2) a boundary description of the CCN service area.
