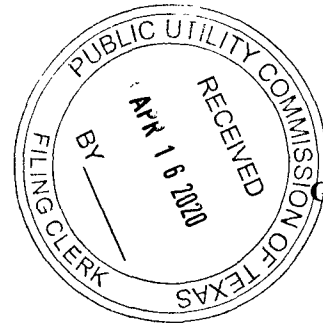

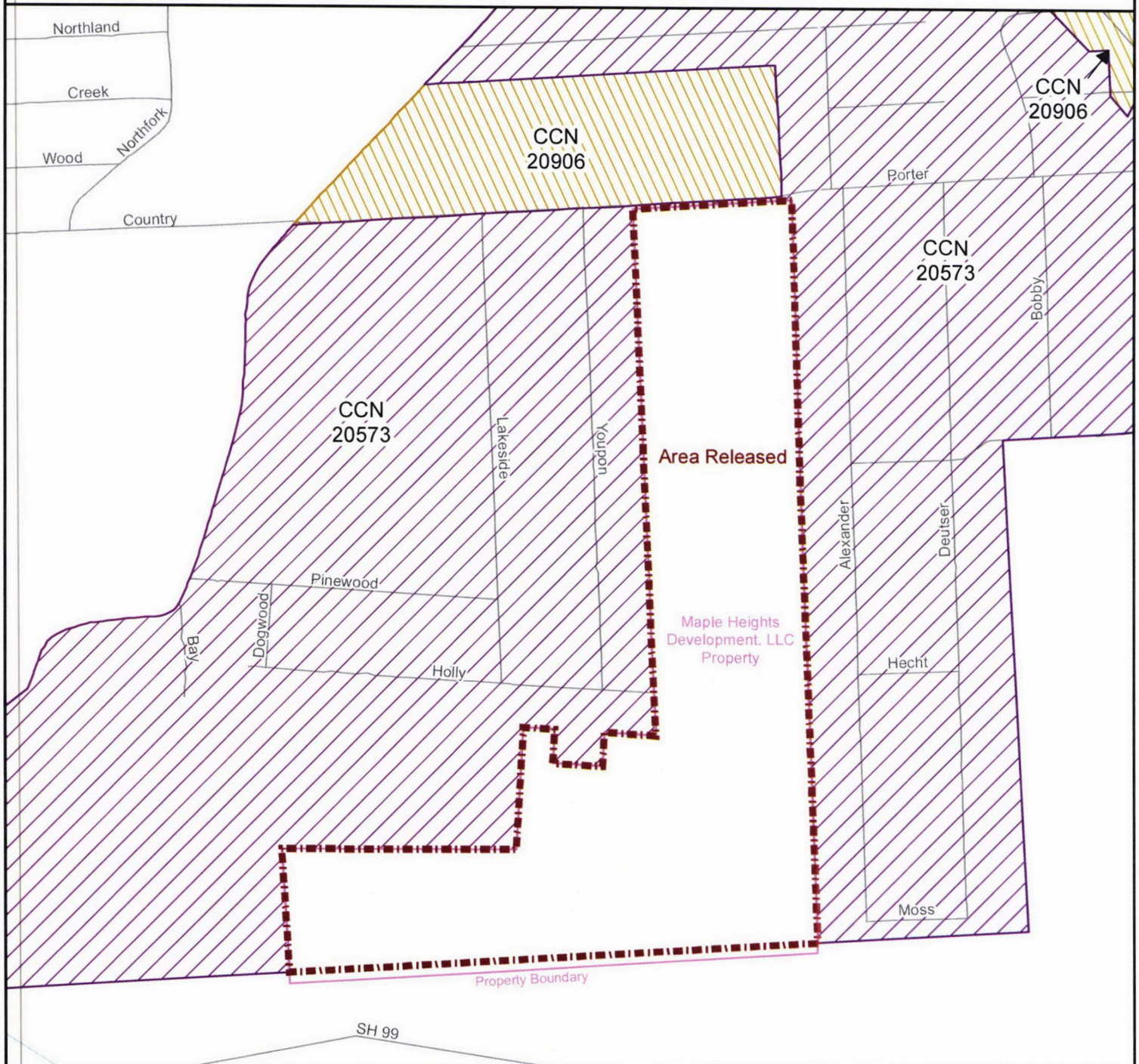

Porter Municipal Utility District

having obtained certification to provide sewer utility service for the convenience and necessity of the public, and it having been determined by this Commission that the public convenience and necessity would in fact be advanced by the provision of such service, Porter Municipal Utility District is entitled to this

Certificate of Convenience and Necessity No. 20573

to provide continuous and adequate sewer utility service to that service area or those service areas in Montgomery County as by final Order or Orders duly entered by this Commission, which Order or Orders resulting from Docket No. 49924 are on file at the Commission offices in Austin, Texas; and are matters of official record available for public inspection; and be it known further that these presents do evidence the authority and the duty of the Porter Municipal Utility District to provide such utility service in accordance with the laws of this State and Rules of this Commission, subject only to any power and responsibility of this Commission to revoke or amend this Certificate in whole or in part upon a subsequent showing that the public convenience and necessity would be better served thereby.
