**ORDER NO. 2
FINDING PETITION INCOMPLETE AND
ESTABLISHING AN OPPORTUNITY TO CURE**

This Order addresses the administrative completeness of the petition filed on August 30, 2019, by Maple Heights Development LLC for expedited release from the Porter Municipal Utility District sewer certificate of convenience and necessity (CCN) in Montgomery County by expedited release. On September 30, 2019, Commission Staff filed a recommendation on administrative completeness.


The administrative law judge finds the application is administratively incomplete and insufficient for further review.

On or before October 30, 2019, the applicant must supplement the application to cure the deficiencies described in Roshan Pokhrel's September 30, 2019 memorandum. Until the Commission receives and reviews the supplemental information, the application cannot proceed.

On or before November 29, 2019, Commission Staff must file a supplemental recommendation regarding the administrative completeness of the application, along with a proposed procedural schedule, if appropriate.
