ORDER NO. 4 FINDING APPLICATION ADMINISTRATIVELY COMPLETE; REQUIRING NOTICE; AND ESTABLISHING A PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

This Order addresses the administrative completeness of Crystal Clear Special Utility District's application filed on September 3, 2019, for a name change and to amend its sewer certificate of convenience and necessity in Comal, Hays, and Guadalupe Counties.

The administrative law judge (ALJ) finds the application administratively complete and directs Crystal Clear to provide notice of the application as described in the December 16, 2019, memorandum of Nabaraj Pokharel, using the included forms.

The ALJ adopts the following procedural schedule:

Deadline for Crystal Clear to file signed affidavits that the notice was provided, along with a copy of the notice and map sent to the affected parties, and published in a newspaper of general circulation	· · · · · · · · · · · · · · · · · · ·
Deadline for Commission Staff to file a recommendation on sufficiency of notice	Within 10 days of Crystal Clear filing proof of completed notice with the Commission
Deadline to intervene	30 days after notice is issued
