## ORDER NO. 5 GRANTING INTERVENTION

This Order addresses the motion to intervene of the City of San Marcos, filed on January 24, 2020. The motion to intervene was timely filed and was not opposed.

San Marcos states that a portion of the proposed service area sought by Crystal Clear Special Utility District is located within its extraterritorial jurisdiction and directly borders the City's corporate limits. Further, San Marcos states that it has existing collection lines and force mains bordering or within near proximity to the area sought for certification, and if the application is granted, San Marcos will no longer have the opportunity to respond to neighboring or nearby landowner requests.

The administrative law judge (ALJ) concludes that San Marcos has demonstrated that it has a justiciable interest which may be adversely affected by the outcome of the proceeding and has standing to intervene under 16 Texas Administrative Code § 22.103.

Accordingly, the ALJ grants San Marcos' motion to intervene.
