COMMISSION STAFF'S THIRD REQUEST FOR EXTENSION

On September 4, 2019, Community Water Service, Inc. (Community) and Patterson Water Supply, LLC (Patterson) (collectively, Applicants) filed an application for approval of the sale, transfer, or merger of water facilities and certificate rights in Dallas and Denton counties. Specifically, the Applicants seek to transfer all of Community's water service area and associated facilities to Patterson's water service area under Certificate of Convenience and Necessity (CCN) No. 13248 and to cancel Community's water CCN No. 10091.

On January 11, 2021, the administrative law judge (ALJ) filed Order No. 10, requiring Staff of the Public Utility Commission of Texas (Staff) to a proposed notice of approval, including proposed findings of fact, conclusions of law, and ordering paragraphs by February 8, 2021. Therefore, this pleading is timely filed.

I. REQUEST FOR EXTENSION

Pursuant to 16 Texas Administrative Code (TAC) § 22.4(b), Staff may request that the time allowed for filing any documents be extended for good cause. Staff emailed the final maps, certificate, and tariff to the Applicants on November 9,2020, but the Applicants have not filed their consent to these documents. Staff again attempted to contact the Applicants on January 29, 2021 regarding the consent forms and did not receive a response. Staff respectfully requests the entry of an order extending the deadline for Staff to file a proposed notice of approval, including proposed findings of fact, conclusions of law, and ordering paragraphs by March 12, 2021.

II. CONCLUSION

Staff respectfully requests an order consistent with the foregoing request.
