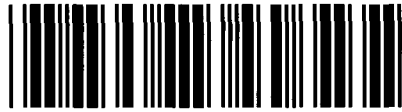

ORDER NO. 2
FINDING APPLICATION AND NOTICE SUFFICIENT
AND ESTABLISHING PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

This Order addresses the application of Wind Energy Transmission Texas, LLC to amend its certificate of convenience and necessity for the Juno Solar Station-to-Long Draw Switching Station for a new electric transmission facility in Borden County. On October 31, 2019, Commission Staff filed a recommendation on the application and notice, and a proposed procedural schedule.

On October 24, 2019 Wind Energy filed the affidavit of Derrick Berg, senior environmental planner and project manager, attesting to the service of notice to municipalities, counties, neighboring utilities, the Department of Defense Siting Clearinghouse, the Office of Public Utility Counsel, landowners, and Texas Parks and Wildlife. Further, Wind Energy filed the affidavit of Kerri Dean, editor, attesting to the publication of notice in the *Borden Star* on October 9, 2019.

The administrative law judge finds the application administratively complete and the notice sufficient. The procedural schedule proposed by Commission Staff is adopted, as follows:
