DEFINITIONS

- 1) "Applicant," "the Company" or "you" refers to Big Wood Springs Water System and any person acting or purporting to act on their behalf, including without limitation, attorneys, agents, advisors, investigators, representatives, employees or other persons.
- 2) "Document" includes any written, recorded, or graphic matter, however produced or reproduced, including but not limited to correspondence, telegrams, contracts, agreements, notes in any form, memoranda, diaries, voice recording tapes, microfilms, pictures, computer media, work papers, calendars, minutes of meetings or other writings or graphic matter, including copies containing marginal notes or variations of any of the foregoing, now or previously in your possession. In the event any documents requested by this Request for Information have been transferred beyond the Company's control, describe the circumstances under which the document was destroyed or transferred and provide an exact citation to the subject document. In the event that documents containing the exact information do not exist, but documents do exist which contain portions of the required information or which contain substantially similar information, then the definition of "documents" shall include the documents which do exist, and these documents will be provided.

- Staff 1-1 Please provide a probated will or other document confirming that David Petty is the executor of Paterteen Petty's estate.
- Staff 1-2 Please admit or deny that Paterteen Petty was operating Big Wood Springs Water system or Springs Water System or Big Wood Springs Water Company as a sole proprietorship before she was deceased. If admit, provide any document demonstrating this fact.
- Staff 1-3 If the answer to Staff 1-2 is deny, please provide any document, other than a tariff issued by the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality or Public Utility Commission, demonstrating the form of business under which Big Wood Springs Water System or Big Wood Springs Water Company is operating.
- Staff 1-4 Did Paterteen Petty have an assumed name certificate on file with Hopkins, Wood, or any other county in Texas in which Big Wood Springs Water Company or Big Wood Springs Water System operates? If the answer is yes, please provide a copy of the assumed name certificate.
- Staff 1-5 Please provide a full copy of the most recently approved tariff for water Certificate of Convenience and Necessity No. 12367 that is in your possession.
- Staff 1-6 Reference Water Tariff Page No. 2 filed on September 17, 2019, as part of the original application. Please admit or deny that Pat McCoy is the same person as Paterteen Petty. If deny, please explain who Pat McCoy is and confirm whether Pact McCoy is living or deceased.
- Staff 1-7 Please provide a copy of water Certificate of Convenience and Necessity No. 12367 issued by the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality or its predecessor agency.
