ORDER NO. 3 FINDING APPLICATION ADMINISTRATIVELY COMPLETE, REQUIRING NOTICE, ESTABLISHING PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE, AND RESTYLING APPLICATION

This Order addresses the September 17, 2019, application of Pure Utilities, LC and Undine Texas, LLC for sale, transfer, or merger of water facilities and certificate rights in Liberty, Polk, San Jacinto, and Tyler counties, and to decertify a portion of Pure Utilities, LC's certificated area and to amend uncertificated water service area in Liberty and Polk counties and the proposed notice, administrative completeness of the application and request to restyle the application.

The administrative law judge (ALJ) finds the application administratively complete and directs the applicants to provide notice of the application and proof of notice in the manner and form described in Roshan Pokhrel's memorandum dated December 18, 2019. Also, the ALJ grants the request to restyle the application to add uncertificated area and the request for decertification of a portion Pure Utilities' water certificate of convenience and necessity area.

The following procedural schedule applies:

Deadline for applicants to file signed affidavits that notice was provided, along with a copy of the notice sent to the affected parties	February 3, 2020
Deadline for Commission Staff to file a recommendation on sufficiency of notice	Within 10 days of applicants filing proof of completed notice
