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APPLICATION OF PURE UTILITIES, LC AND UNDINE TEXAS ENVIRONMENTAL, LLC FOR SALE, TRANSFER, OR MERGER OF SEWER FACILITIES AND CERTIFICATE RIGHTS AND TO DECERTIFY A PORTION OF PURE UTILITIES, LC'S CERTIFICATED AREA, AND TO AMEND UNCERTIFICATED SEWER SERVICE AREA IN POLK COUNTY

#### AGREED REQUEST FOR EXTENSION

**COMES NOW** the Staff (Staff) of the Public Utility Commission of Texas (Commission), representing the public interest, and with the agreement of Pure Utilities, LC (Pure) and Undine Texas, LLC (Undine) (collectively, the Parties), files this Request for Extension

#### I. BACKGROUND

On September 17, 2019, Pure and Undine (collectively, Applicants) filed an application for the sale, transfer, or merger of facilities and certificate rights in Polk County. The Applicants seeks approval to transfer all of Pure's sewer service area held under certificate of convenience and necessity (CCN) No. 20557 to Undine, and to amend additional area and decertify a small area in order to clean up the service area boundaries. The total requested area includes approximately 597 acres and 184 connections. The area to be transferred is approximately 333 acres. The additional area to be amended is approximately 288 acres, and the area to be decertified is approximately 24 acres.

On November 19, 2020, Order No. 11 was filed establishing a deadline of December 21, 2020, for Staff to provide final maps, certificates, and tariffs. Therefore, this pleading is timely filed.

#### II. AGREED REQUEST FOR EXTENSION

Under 16 Texas Administrative Code § 22.4(b), Staff may request that the time allowed for filing any documents be extended for good cause. Staff is continuing to work to prepare final maps, certificates, and tariffs; however, Staff needs additional time to complete the proposed final

tariff. Thus, Staff respectfully requests the entry of an order extending the deadline for Staff to provide final maps, certificates, and tariffs to January 8, 2020, and extending the remaining deadlines in this docket by the same amount to time. Staff has discussed this request with counsel for the Applicants who indicated that the Applicants are in agreement with the requested extension.

#### **III. CONCLUSION**

The Parties respectfully request the entry of an order consistent with the above request for extension.
