AGREED REQUEST FOR EXTENSION

COMES NOW the Staff (Staff) of the Public Utility Commission of Texas (Commission), representing the public interest, and with the agreement of Pure Utilities, LC (Pure) and Undine Texas Environmental, LLC (Undine) (collectively, the Parties), files this Request for Extension

I. BACKGROUND

On September 17, 2019, Pure and Undine (collectively, Applicants) filed an application for the sale, transfer, or merger of facilities and certificate rights in Polk County. The Applicants seeks approval to transfer all of Pure's sewer service area held under certificate of convenience and necessity (CCN) No. 20557 to Undine, and to amend additional area and decertify a small area in order to clean up the service area boundaries. The total requested area includes approximately 597 acres and 184 connections. The area to be transferred is approximately 333 acres. The additional area to be amended is approximately 288 acres, and the area to be decertified is approximately 24 acres.

On December 22, 2020, Order No. 12 was filed establishing a deadline of January 8, 2021, for Staff to provide final maps, certificates, and tariffs. Staff timely provided final maps and now seeks this extension request in order to allow more time to prepare the final certificates and tariffs.

II. REQUEST FOR EXTENSION

Under 16 Texas Administrative Code § 22.4(b), Staff may request that the time allowed for filing any documents be extended for good cause. Staff is continuing to work to prepare final certificates and tariffs; however, Staff requires additional time to finalize the documents.

Therefore, Staff respectfully requests the entry of an order extending the deadline for Staff to provide final, certificates and tariffs to January 15, 2021, and for the remainder of the dates in the existing procedural schedule to be adjusted as requested below.

III. PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

In accordance with Staff's extension request, Staff proposes the following procedural schedule for the further processing of this docket:

Deadline for Staff to provide final certificates and tariffs, to Applicants for review and consent	January 15, 2021
Deadline for Applicants to file signed consent forms with the Commission	January 29, 2021
Deadline for parties to jointly file Proposed Notice of Approval, including findings of fact, conclusions of law, and ordering paragraphs	February 12, 2021

III. CONCLUSION

Staff respectfully requests the entry of an order consistent with the above request for extension and proposed procedural schedule.
