FINDING NOTICE SUFFICIENT AND  
ESTABLISHING PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE**

This Order addresses the sufficiency of notice provided by Gum Island Utility and East Houston Utilities, Inc. dba Krebs Utilities and establishes a procedural schedule for continued processing.

On April 15, 2020, the applicants filed the affidavit of Stephen Krebs, owner if Krebs Utilities, affirming that notice was mailed on March 26, 2020 to all customers and other affected parties identified in Commission Staff's third supplemental recommendation on administrative completeness filed on March 10, 2020. This list was also included as Attachment A in applicant's filing of April 1, 2020.

The administrative law judge finds the notice sufficient and establishes the following procedural schedule:

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<sup>1</sup> Under 16 TAC § 24.239(b), the intervention period shall not be less than 30 days unless good cause is shown. Notice was mailed on March 26, 2020, and 30 days after March 26, 2020, is April 25, 2020. Because, the Commission is closed for business on April 25, 2020, the deadline becomes April 27, 2020 under 16 TAC § 22.4(a).

Deadline for parties to file a joint motion to admit evidence and proposed order approving sale and allowing transaction to proceed	June 17, 2020
120-day deadline for the Commission to approve the sale or require a hearing	July 24, 2020 <sup>2</sup>
