**ORDER NO. 12
REQUIRING STATUS REPORT**

This Order addresses the need for a report regarding the status of the sale in this proceeding. Specifically, on Order No. 11 filed on May 19, 2021 required Madera Valley Water Supply Corporation and the Town of Pecos City to file a status report in compliance of Order No. 7 by June 1, 2021.¹ The applicants have not filed a response to Order No. 11. The applicants' last report was filed on March 30, 2021.

The administrative law judge requests that Commission Staff reach out to the applicants to provide assistance for status reports.

By July 1, 2021, *and continuing monthly thereafter*, Commission Staff, Madera Valley and Pecos must file joint reports regarding the status of the closing of their transaction. Additionally, the parties must file a statement explaining why the sale has not been completed, nor has an extension of time been requested, within the required 180 days set forth in Order No. 7.
