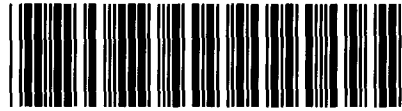

The Office of Public Utility Counsel (“OPUC”) respectfully files these comments in response to Undine Texas, LLC and Undine Texas Environmental, LLC’s (collectively, “Undine”) requested modifications to discovery deadlines established by the Administrative Law Judges (“ALJs”) in State Office of Administrative Hearings (“SOAH”) Order No. 1. SOAH Order No. 1 states that the deadline to file comments on the proposed procedural schedule for this proceeding is May 1, 2020, therefore this filing is timely. OPUC has no objections to the modification requests filed by Undine. OPUC’s sole modification request to the discovery deadlines established by the ALJs in SOAH Order No. 1 includes:


For written discovery on Staff’s and Intervenors’ direct testimony: Responses are due within 6 calendar days of the discovery request, rather than 4.


