## TO WHOM IT MAY CONCERN:

This letter is in protest to a requested fee hike from Undine Texas, LLC. The residents of Bolivar Peninsula are on a sewage system developed by Bolivar Utility Services and sold to Undine in 2019. We are opposed to the proposed rate hikes.

Bolivar Utility Services (BUS) began developing this system after Hurricane Ike and maintained and serviced it until the sale to Undine. When the Bolivar Sewage System was installed, BUS required each customer to install a large holding tank with a macerator system at the cost of \$10,000 per household. In addition, there was a line tap fee. These costs were paid by each and every customer on the BUS System. The entire system is up to date and not in need of any repairs.

Undine claims that in order to comply with the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (TCEQ) and EPA regulations, Undine must update dilapidated sewage systems it has recently purchased. On their website they show photographs of old and deteriorating sewage systems. This is not the case with the system on Bolivar Peninsula.

Most of the Bolivar residences are vacation homes that seldom meet the minimum gallonage usage per month. The request made by Undine is approximately a 250% increase over the current rate of \$40 per month, and is totally out of line.

Undine has been in business since 2016. They obviously purchased dilapidated and run- down sewage systems as part of their holdings. They now request the increase in order to bring these systems up to regulation. It is not the



responsibility of customers on Bolivar Peninsula to pay for Undine's bad business decisions.

We respectfully request that PUCT deny any requests for increases to Undine, LLC. Your consideration is appreciated.
