**ORDER NO. 1  
REQUIRING COMMENTS ON ADMINISTRATIVE COMPLETENESS  
AND NOTICE; AND ESTABLISHING PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE**

**I. Petition**

This Order addresses the November 6, 2019, application of Harlan Properties, Inc. to amend High Point Water Supply Corporation's water certificate of convenience and necessity (CCN) in Kaufman County by expedited release. The applicants seek the decertification of 213 acres of land within the boundaries of water CCN number 10841 held by High Point.

**II. Requiring Comments on the Administrative Completeness**

By December 6, 2019, Commission Staff must file comments regarding the administrative completeness of the petition and notice.

High Point or any other interested person must file a motion to intervene by December 6, 2019, in order to participate as a party in this proceeding.

**III. Establishing Procedural Schedule**

The following procedural schedule applies to this proceeding:

Commission Staff's comments on the administrative completeness of the petition and notice	December 6, 2019
Deadline for High Point and other affected persons to file a motion to intervene or comment on the petition	December 6, 2019

Additional deadlines will be established after the petition is deemed administratively complete.

**IV. Filing Requirements**

Unless otherwise specified, an original and ten copies of documents relating to this proceeding must be filed with the Commission's filing clerk in accordance with 16 TAC § 22.71.

A copy of each document filed with the Commission must also be served on all parties as required by 16 TAC § 22.74. All filings can be accessed on the PUC Interchange webpage at, <http://interchange.puc.texas.gov>.


