**ORDER NO. 2  
FINDING APPLICATION INCOMPLETE AND DEFICIENT,  
AND ESTABLISHING AN OPPORTUNITY TO CURE**

This Order addresses the November 12, 2019, application of City of Bruceville-Eddy and Elm Creek Water Supply Corporation for approval of the sale, transfer, or merger of facilities and certificates of convenience and necessity rights in McLennan County.


The administrative law judge finds the application incomplete and deficient. Under 16 Texas Administrative Code § 24.8(d), the Commission does not consider an application filed until it makes a determination that the application is administratively complete. Thus, at this time the application is not considered filed with the Commission.

On or before January 13, 2020, the applicants must supplement the application to cure the deficiencies as described in the December 12, 2019, memorandum by Roshan Pokhrel. Until the Commission receives and reviews the supplemental information, the application cannot proceed. The applicants must not issue notice until the application is deemed administratively complete.

On or before February 10, 2020, Commission Staff must file a supplemental recommendation regarding the administrative completeness of the application, along with a proposed procedural schedule, if appropriate.
