



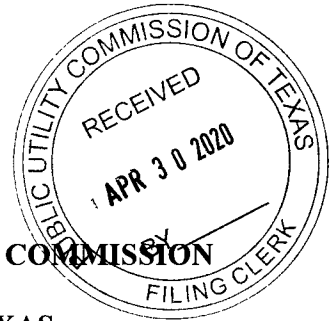

**ORDER NO. 5
FINDING NOTICE SUFFICIENT AND ESTABLISHING A PROCEDURAL
SCHEDULE**

This Order addresses the application of Quadvest LP and the sufficiency of notice and establishes a procedural schedule.

Quadvest filed proof of completed notice on March 30, 2020 and March 31, 2020, and supplemented its proof of notice with an example of the actual notice that was published in the newspaper on April 8, 2020. The administrative law judge finds the notice sufficient. The following procedural schedule applies:


Event	Date
Deadline to intervene	April 16, 2020 ¹
Deadline for Commission Staff to provide final maps, certificates, and tariffs (if applicable) to Quadvest for review and consent	May 29, 2020
Deadline for Quadvest to file signed consent forms with the Commission	June 12, 2020
If no hearing is requested, deadline for Commission Staff to file a final recommendation on the application	June 19, 2020
If no hearing is requested, deadline for parties to file a joint motion to admit evidence and proposed findings of fact, conclusions of law, and ordering paragraphs	June 26, 2020

¹ Under 16 Texas Administrative Code § 24.235(a)(3), the intervention deadline is 30 days after the mailing or publication of notice, whichever occurs later. Notice was mailed on March 17, 2020 and published on February 4, 2020 and February 11, 2020. Thirty days after March 17, 2020 is April 16, 2020.
