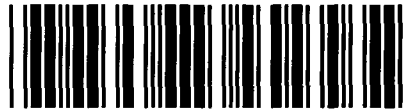





Quadvest, L.P has filed an application with the Public Utility Commission of Texas to amend its Certificate of Convenience and Necessity (CCN) No. 11612 and CCN No. 20952 for the provision of retail water and sewer utility service in Harris County.

The requested area is located approximately 5 miles west of downtown Tomball, TX, and is generally bounded on the north by Spring Creek; on the east by Country Hill; on the south by Waller Tomball Road/ FM 2920; and on the west by Decker Prairie-Rosehill Road. The requested area includes approximately 51 total acres and 0 current customers.

The requested area overlaps the boundaries of the districts below:

- Coastal Water Authority
- Gulf Coast Waste Disposal Authority
- Harris County Flood Control District
- H-M-W SUD
- North Harris County Regional Water Authority
- Port of Houston Authority

If any of the above districts or entities do not request a public hearing, the Commission shall determine that the district or entity is consenting to the QUADVEST, L.P.'s request to provide retail water and sewer utility service in the requested area.

Hearing- and speech-impaired individuals with text telephones (TTY) may contact the commission at (512) 936-7136. The deadline for intervention in the proceeding is (30 days from the mailing or publication of notice, whichever occurs later, unless otherwise provided by the presiding officer). You must send a letter requesting intervention to the commission which is received by that date.

If a valid public hearing is requested, the Commission will forward the application to the State Office of Administrative Hearings (SOAH) for a hearing. If no settlement is reached and an evidentiary hearing is held, SOAH will submit a recommendation to the Commission for a final decision. An evidentiary hearing is a legal proceeding similar to a civil trial in state district court.

A landowner with a tract of land at least 25 acres or more, that is partially or wholly located within the requested area, may file a written request with the Commission to be excluded from the requested area ("opt out") within (30) days from the date that notice was provided by the Utility. All opt out requests must include a large-scale map and a metes and bounds description of the landowner's tract of land.
