SUPPLEMENTAL PROOF OF NOTICE**


CSWR-Texas Utility Operating Company, LLC ("CSWR Texas") submits this Supplemental Proof of Notice, and states as follows:

CSWR Texas filed an Application for Sale, Transfer, or Merger of Facilities and Certificate Rights in Victoria County with the Public Utility Commission of Texas ("Commission") on November 18, 2019. Pursuant to Order No. 3, CSWR Texas filed its Proof of Notice on February 21, 2020 affirming that notice to current customers in the requested area was completed on February 6, 2020. Subsequent to filing the Proof of Notice, CSWR Texas became aware of additional addresses for some customers who were previously notified on February 6, 2020. 

Before me, the undersigned authority, Josiah Cox, being first duly sworn, deposes and states as follows:

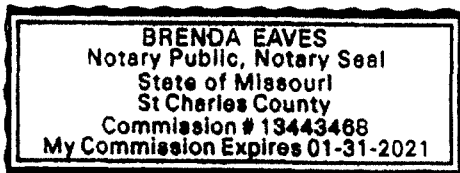

Persons who wish to intervene in the proceeding or comment upon action sought should contact the Public Utility Commission, P.O. Box 13326, Austin, Texas 78711-3336, or call the Public Utility Commission at (512) 936-7120 or (888) 782-8477. Hearing- and speech-impaired individuals with text telephones (TTY) may contact the commission at (512) 936-7136. The deadline for intervention in the proceeding is (30 days from the mailing or publication of notice, whichever occurs later, unless otherwise provided by the presiding officer). You must send a letter requesting intervention to the commission which is received by that date.

If a valid public hearing is requested, the Commission will forward the application to the State Office of Administrative Hearings (SOAH) for a hearing. If no settlement is reached and an evidentiary hearing is held, SOAH will submit a recommendation to the Commission for final decision. An evidentiary hearing is a legal proceeding similar to a civil trial in state district court.
