This Order addresses the November 20, 2019, petition of Clay Road 628 Development, LP for expedited release from Simply Aquatics, Inc.'s certificate of convenience and necessity (CCN) in Montgomery County. Clay Road 628 seeks the expedited release of the portion of its 269-acre tract that lies within the boundaries of Simply Aquatics' water CCN number 13259.

II. Requiring Comments on the Administrative Completeness

Simply Aquatics or any other interested person must file a motion to intervene by December 20, 2019, in order to participate in this proceeding.

IV. Filing Requirements

Unless otherwise specified, an original and ten copies of documents relating to this proceeding must be filed with the Commission's filing clerk in accordance with 16 TAC § 22.71.

A copy of each document filed with the Commission must also be served on all parties as required by 16 TAC § 22.74. All filings can be accessed on the PUC Interchange webpage at, <http://interchange.puc.texas.gov>.


