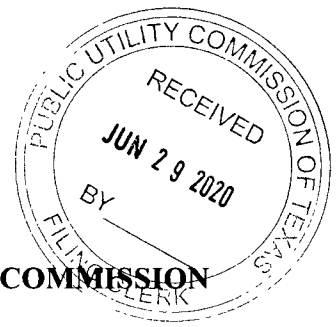

**ORDER NO. 5
 FINDING NOTICE DEFICIENT AND
 REVISING PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE**

This Order addresses the application of SWWC Utilities, Inc. dba Water Services, Inc. and Monarch Utilities, I, L.P. for approval of the sale, transfer, or merger of facilities and certificate, and the deficiencies of the notice.

The administrative law judge finds the notice deficient and directs the applicants to provide proper notice to the groundwater conservation districts (GCDs) as detailed in Commission Staff's May 15, 2020 recommendation. Additionally, the notice provided to the GCDs be amended to reflect the intervention deadline detailed below. Further, the applicants must file an electronic version of the maps provided to affected parties via hyperlink included in the notice. The following revised procedural applies:

Event	Date
Deadline for applicants to file with the Commission signed affidavits that the notice was given to the aforementioned GCDs along with a copy of the notice sent to the affected parties	July 9, 2020
Deadline for Commission Staff to file a recommendation on sufficiency of notice	July 16, 2020
Deadline to intervene	Thirty days after notice is issued
