**ORDER NO. 7
GRANTING EXTENSION AND
AMENDING PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE**

This Order addresses Commission Staff's request for extension and amends the procedural schedule for continued processing.

On August 25, 2020, Commission Staff filed a request for extension of the deadline to file its recommendation on the approval of the sale and CCN amendment. Commission Staff requests the extension to allow for additional time for the applicants to respond to outstanding discovery requests and for Commission Staff to review the documents.

The administrative law judge grants the extension. On or before September 18, 2020, Commission Staff must request a hearing or file a recommendation on the approval of the sale and on the CCN amendment.

Accordingly, the procedural schedule is amended as follows:

Deadline for Commission Staff to request a hearing or file a recommendation on the approval of the sale and on the CCN amendment	September 18, 2020
Deadline for parties to file a response to Commission Staff's recommendation on the approval of the sale	September 25, 2020
Deadline for parties to file a joint motion to admit evidence and proposed order approving sale and allowing transaction to proceed. See Docket No. 49615, Order No. 6 for details	October 9, 2020

120-day deadline for Commission to approve the sale or require a hearing	October 26, 2020 ¹
