## ORDER NO. 4 FINDING NOTICE SUFFICIENT AND ESTABLISHING A PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

This Order addresses the application of County Line Special Utility District and the sufficiency of notice and establishes a procedural schedule.

County Line provided signed affidavits attesting that notice was provided on April 2, 2020. The administrative law judge finds the notice sufficient. The following procedural schedule applies:

Deadline to intervene	May 4, 2020 <sup>1</sup>
Deadline for Commission Staff to provide final maps, certificates, and tariffs (if applicable) to County Line for review and consent	July 3, 2020
Deadline for County Line to file signed consent forms with the Commission	July 17, 2020
If no hearing is requested, deadline for Commission Staff to file a final recommendation on the application	July 24, 2020
If no hearing is requested, deadline for parties to file a joint motion to admit evidence and proposed findings of fact, conclusions of law, and ordering paragraphs	August 7, 2020
