**ORDER NO. 16  
AMENDING EVIDENCE**

On October 18, 2021, Commission filed a memorandum requesting County Line Special Utility District to clarify findings of fact No. 18 and 19 in the revised proposed order filed on September 15, 2021. Specifically, to confirm whether County Line SUD has received written requests for sewer service for any homes or businesses in the City of Umland, shown in the purple color-coded areas and identified as “Existing City of Umland Residents” in the County Line SUD modified sewer certificate of convenience and necessity map filed on November 3, 2020.<sup>1</sup> If County Line SUD has received written requests for service for this specific area, to identify the record evidence reflecting the requests for service; file such evidence along with a motion to admit the additional evidence; or file a response indicating the date that County Line SUD intends to file such additional evidence and a motion to admit additional evidence.

On October 21, 2021, County Line SUD clarifies that the proof necessary to support findings of fact Nos. 18 and 19 of the revised proposed order has already been admitted into evidence in this docket through order Nos. 13 and 15. County Line SUD moves to approve the revised proposed order and admits the additional easements in attachment C into evidence.

The administrative law judge grants the motion to admit the additional evidence into the record and approves the revised proposed order filed on September 15, 2021.
