**SETTING DEADLINES FOR RESPONSES FOLLOWING REMAND**

On January 25, 2022, Commission filed an Order remanding this proceeding to Docket Management for further processing.

To facilitate a revised proposed order the administrative law judge sets the following deadlines. By March 9, 2022 County Line Special Utility District must file an amended application with the information described in Commission's Order, and move for the admission of additional evidence into the record. Within 30 days of County Line's filings of an amended application and motion to admit evidence, Commission Staff must file a revised final recommendation with a revised sewer certificate of convenience and necessity map.
