REQUEST FOR EXTENSION AND PROPOSED PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

On December 6, 2019, County Line Special Utility District (County Line) filed an application for a sewer certificate of convenience and necessity in Hays and Caldwell counties under Texas Water Code §§ 13.242–.250 and 16 Texas Administrative Code (TAC) §§ 24.225–.237. The requested area consists of approximately 17,942 acres, 2 existing connections, and 24,100 future connections. On August 28, 2021, the Staff (Staff) of the Public Utility Commission of Texas (Commission) filed its final recommendation recommending the requested area be reduced from 17,492 acres to 7,890 acres.

On February 16, 2022, Order No. 18 was filed, requiring Staff to file a revised final recommendation with a revised sewer certificate of convenience and necessity map to by April 8, 2022¹. This pleading, therefore, is timely filed.

I. REQUEST FOR EXTENSION

Under 16 TAC § 22.4(b), Staff may request that the time allowed for filing any documents be extended for good cause. Staff needs additional time to review County Line SUD’s amended application to prepare its final recommendation. Staff respectfully requests that its deadline to file a revised final recommendation with a revised sewer certificate of convenience and necessity be extended to May 8, 2022. Staff has conferred with counsel for County Line on this request and is authorized to state it is not opposed to the request.

¹ Order No. 18 ordered Count Line SUD to file an amended application with the information described in the Commission’s Order by March 9, 2022, and set Staff’s deadline for 30 days after County Line SUD filed. County Line SUD filed an amended application on March 9, 2022. Therefore, Staff’s deadline to file a revised final recommendation with a revised sewer certificate of convenience and necessity map is April 8, 2022.

II. CONCLUSION

For the foregoing reason, Staff respectfully requests the issuance of an order extending Staff's deadline to file a final revised recommendation with a revised sewer certificated and necessity map to May 8, 2022.
