Docket No. 50324 – Application of County Line Special Utility District to Obtain a Sewer Certificate of Convenience and Necessity in Hays and Caldwell County.

A second revised proposed order filed in the above-referenced docket is posted for consideration and action by the Commission. If the Commission adopts the second revised proposed order, I recommend the following changes to the Commission's order.

Finding of fact 5 should be modified, and finding of fact 26 should be deleted, for consistency with County Line SUD's amended application.

- 5. The application, as supplemented, requests a service area comprised of 7,788 acres and has two current connections and 24,000 potential future connections. There are also 300 homes and business in the Uhland area that currently utilize septic systems which will be able to connect to County Line SUD's centralized wastewater system.
- 26. There are 300 homes and businesses in the Uhland area that currently utilize septic systems which will be able to connect to County Line SUD's centralized wastewater system.

Additionally, the Commission should delegate to the Office of Policy and Docket Management the authority to modify the order to conform to the *Citation and Style Guide for the Public Utility Commission of Texas* and to make other non-substantive changes to the order for such matters as capitalization, spelling, grammar, punctuation, style, correction of numbering, and readability.
