APPLICATION OF GRISTMILL § PUBLIC UTILITY COMMISSION UTILITY COMPANY, LLC TO OBTAIN § A SEWER CERTIFICATE OF § OF TEXAS CONVENIENCE AND NECESSITY IN § HAYS COUNTY §

ORDER NO. 5 REQUIRING COMMISSION STAFF'S COMMENTS ON APPLICANT'S RESPONSE, AND ABATING DEADLINES

This Order addresses Gristmill Utility Company, LLC's (Gristmill) response to Order No. 4 and request for an extension filed on June 10, 2020. In Order No. 4, filed on May 26, 2020, the administrative law judge (ALJ) required Gristmill to supplement the application and to cure the deficiencies described in Greg Charles' May 11, 2020 memorandum, on or before June 10, 2020.

Gristmill responded that Commission Staff's supplemental recommendation filed May 11, 2020, requiring the City of Uhland's (the City) consent for the sewer certificate of convenience and necessity (CCN) overlap is unnecessary. Gristmill indicates the City does not provide sewer service and has requested service from Gristmill through a partnership between Gristmill, the City, and Count Line Special Utility District. Further Gristmill indicates that it already has consent for a sewer CCN overlap from the other sewer service provider, County Line SUD, by a signed agreement.

The ALJ requires Commission Staff to file a response to Gristmill's comments, along with a proposed procedural schedule, if appropriate, on or before August 10, 2020.

The ALJ abates the deadlines set in Order No. 4 and therefore will not rule on Gristmill's request for an extension. If the applicant needs an extension to obtain the City of Uhland's consent it may request one at a future date.
