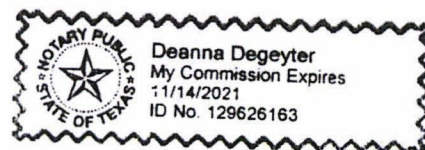

This notice was originally sent on 2-10-2020. The PUC has asked us to send it again after we added the last line in the bottom paragraph to read "charged to your utility".

T&W Water Service received notice from Lone Star Groundwater District (LSGWD) regarding a decrease in the pumpage fees they are charging as part of the Montgomery county-wide water use fee. Effective January 1, 2020 LSGWD will be charging \$0.085 per 1,000 gallons. T&W Water Service had included \$0.06 of the \$0.085 that LSGWD is charging in the last rate increase we had in 2008. Therefore, we are only going to pass through the remaining difference of \$0.025 per 1,000 gallons plus the water loss of 10.2% effective January 1, 2020.

Effective Date of Change: January 1, 2020

PRESENT CALCULATION OF CUSTOMER BILLING BEFORE DECREASE:

G = Gallonage Charge by LSGWD = \$0.045

L = water line loss for preceeding 12 months, not to exceed 0.15 (15%) = 7.6%

R = \$0.045 / (1 - .076)

R = \$0.045 / (0.924) = \$0.05
