

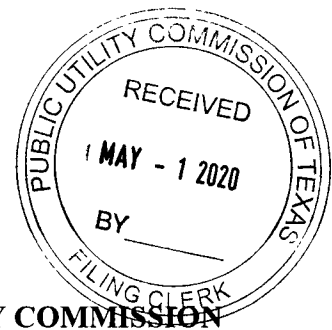

**ORDER NO. 5
FINDING APPLICATION INSUFFICIENT, AND
ESTABLISHING DEADLINES AND OPPORTUNITY TO CURE**

This Order addresses the administrative completeness of the application filed on December 30, 2019, by Nevada Special Utility District (Nevada SUD) to amend its water certificate of convenience and necessity and to decertify portions of certificated water service areas of Caddo Basin Special Utility District, Copeville Special Utility District, and City of Josephine in Collin County.

The administrative law judge finds the application is administratively incomplete and insufficient for further review in accordance with 16 Texas Administrative Code (TAC) § 24.8(b).

Under 16 TAC § 24.8(d), the Commission does not consider an application filed until it finds the application administratively complete. Thus, at this time the application is not considered filed with the Commission.

On or before June 1, 2020, Nevada SUD must supplement the application to cure the deficiencies described in the memorandum of Greg Charles, dated May 1, 2020, attached to Commission Staff's supplemental recommendation on administrative completeness and proposed procedural schedule. Until the Commission receives and reviews the supplemental information, the application cannot proceed. The applicant must not issue notice until the application is deemed administratively complete.

On or before July 1, 2020, Commission Staff must file a supplemental recommendation regarding the administrative completeness of the application, along with a proposed procedural schedule, if appropriate.
