**ORDER NO. 9
FINDING APPLICATION ADMINISTRATIVELY COMPLETE, REQUIRING
NOTICE, AND ESTABLISHING A PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE**

This Order addresses the administrative completeness of the application of Nevada Special Utility District to amend its water certificate of convenience and necessity number 12175, and to decertify portions of water service areas of Caddo Basin Special Utility District, Copeville Special Utility District, and City of Josephine in Collin County.

The administrative law judge (ALJ) finds the application, as supplemented, administratively complete and directs Nevada SUD to provide notice of the application as described in the November 2, 2020 memorandum of Reginald Tuvilla, using the included forms.

The ALJ adopts the following procedural schedule:

Deadline for Nevada SUD to file with the Commission signed affidavits that the notice was given along with a copy of the notice sent to the affected parties and published in a newspaper of general circulation in Collin County	December 16, 2020
Deadline for Commission Staff to file a recommendation on sufficiency of notice and propose a supplemental procedural schedule	December 30, 2020
Deadline to intervene	30 days after notice is issued
